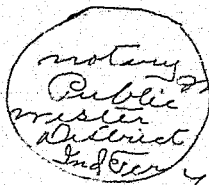

within and for the above named District and Territory personally appeared Julia - Toney (nee Brown) and who being by me duly sworn according to law depose and say:

That her name is Julia Toney, nee Brown and is the wife of Jake Toney, and their post office address is Brush Hill Ind. Terr., that affiant is the mother of Belle Jackson now deceased and said Belle Jackson was born out of wedlock and was an illegitimate child of this affiant, that said child was born on or about the 5<sup>th</sup> day of September 1898, and died on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of July in the year 1899; that said child was a Creek Freedman and as such was enrolled on the records of the Commission to the Five Civilized Tribes and allotted in the Creek Nation. That the said property is more particularly described as follows: The southwest quarter of Section four (4) Township eighteen (18) north and range twelve (12) east of the Indian Base and Meridian. That affiant together with her husband sold and conveyed the above described land to O. F. Parks of Muskogee Ind. Terr., dated March 18, 1905 and at the time of said conveyance there was doubt in the minds of both parties therein as to what title was conveyed; that affiant has on this day and date in order to set at rest all questions and controversies in regard to the matter affiant has received and accepted the sum of Fifty Dollars in full of all demands against the said O. F. Parks and is a full settlement and compromise of the matter and affiant will not assert or
