Campbell Land & Oil Co. This Agreement made
 and entered into by and
 between Campbell Land
 and Oil Company, a
 corporation under the laws of Oklahoma Territory
 party of the first part, and R. C. Brady her heirs and assigns
 party of the second part Witnesseth:

Party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Five (\$5.00) Dollars in hand paid by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is here by acknowledged by the party of the first part, and for the further consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter contained, hereby grants to the party of the second part, for the period of fifteen years, a right of way for a railway track or spur extending from the main line of Frisco Rail road tract to the west side of the Arkansas River in the Creek Nation, Indian Territory, along the river front of said Arkansas River on the north side of said Frisco Railway for a distance of 400 feet from the said Frisco Railway Right of way or as much farther as may be necessary for the carrying on of the business hereinafter mentioned. The party of the second part shall have the right to construct a rail road tract or spur on the land of the party of the first part at the place and for the distance above mentioned, and shall have the right to use as much land as

is necessary and proper for the operating a plant for taking sand out of the Arkansas River, and loading on cars on said tract.

Parties of the second part shall have the exclusive right during the period of this contract to take sand for commercial purpose from that portion of the Arkansas River adjacent to the land now belonging to the Party of the first part, and the party of the first part agrees not to grant to any other person, firm or corporation the right of taking sand from said river adjacent to said property during said term.
