have this day and do by these presents hereby grant,
bargain, sell and forever quit-claim unto the said

and assigns all our right title and interest either
legal or equitable in and to the following described
real estate situate in the City of Tulsa Indian
Territory to wit: All of Block No. thirty-five (35)
thirty-six (36) Sixty-four (^{and} ~~four~~) Sixty-six (66) as shown
by the official plat of the said City of Tulsa Indian
Territory approved by the Secretary of the Interior.
To Have and to Hold the same unto the said The Frisco
Oil and Gas Company its successors and assigns forever.

And I, Virlea Wayland Jackson wife of the said Jabez
N. Jackson for and in consideration of the said sum of
money aforesaid do hereby release and relinquish unto the
said The Frisco Oil & Gas Company all my right of dower
and homestead in and to said land aforesaid.
