 therefor

And for the consideration aforesaid and for divers
 and other good considerations we, to warrant and
 defend the title to the above described land as
 herein set forth — do hereby release and for-
 ever quit claim unto the said Robert Pollock and
 his heirs, successors and assigns all my right
 claim or possibility of dower and homestead in and
 to the aforegranted premises.
