To Have and to Hold the same unto the said Loren Conaway, and unto his heirs and assigns forever with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby Covenant and agree with said Loren Conaway that it will forever warrant and defend the title to said lands against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
