

to be sold but a brief, general and comprehensive description of such property shall be sufficient.

The said trustee may, in his discretion, sell and take from time and for such time, and at such place and for such public announcement of such advertisement, and of the time to which the sale shall be adjourned to be made by proclamation, at the time and place fixed for said sale or any adjournment thereof, and if said sale shall be adjourned the said trustee may make such sale at the time to which the same may be so adjourned, and at such sale may sell all of the said state, property and rights of every kind and nature whether hereby conveyed or intended to be conveyed containing with such additional requirements as may be imposed by the laws of Oklahoma existing on the future date of Oklahoma.

After such sale the said trustee shall execute and deliver to the purchaser or purchasers of such state, property and rights, a deed or conveyance thereof, good and sufficient in law to convey all such property to the purchaser or purchasers thereof, freed from all and every the trusts and liens hereby created and without liability upon the purchaser to see to the application of the purchase money, and without obligation upon the purchaser to inquire into the necessity or expediency or authority of or for any such sale or the regularity of any proceeding incident thereto, whether made in whole or in part by a judicial officer, both of law and in equity, against the said Oklahoma Corporation, and all persons claiming, or to claim, the said state and property sold.
