Contract between Attorney and Client
The contract and agreement made and
entered into on the 11th day of May, 1916, by
and between Mrs. Mrs. B. Burgess and Julia
Lucina Combs, party of the first part, and
Charles H. Harnage, party of the second part,
party of the second part, witness;

Thomas, the party of the first part
is one of the heirs of John S. Burgess deceased
Charles Alton, the heirs of said deceased being
Mrs. B. Burgess widow, Carrie V. Harnage daughter,
Alma V. Shipman daughter, and David S. Burgess
son, and Thomas and John S. Burgess said said
and possessed of certain improvements on
land situated north and adjoining the town-
site of Tulsa Indian Territory, said land containing
eighty nine (89) acres more or less, and being herein
after more particularly described, and said land
being held on by said Mrs. B. Burgess, an adopted
white citizen of the Cherokee Nation and

Thomas the night of said Mrs. B. Burgess
& Alton in the Cherokee Nation, are now
being litigated in the Supreme Court of the United
States and the decision of said court will in all
probability be adverse to said Mrs. B. Burgess,
and Thomas, and John S. Burgess said, prior to
his death been indicated by said Thomas to make
deed to certain property situated in north
Tulsa said property being more particularly
described as follows to-wit: two, three, and six
and six Block five; Lots one, two, three and six,
Block fourth, and Lot one and two, Block three,
all in north Tulsa Cherokee Nation Indian
Territory, and;

Whereas said party of the second part
has successfully transmitted an appeal to the
Honorable Secretary of the Interior, wherein
it has been ordered by decision of the Honorable
Secretary dated May 2, 1916, that the said party
of the first part be allowed to cancel
