Perryman a single man parties of the first part and Dave Hunt parties of the second part Witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Eighteen Hundred Seventy five (\$1875.00) Dollars in hand paid by the said party of the second part the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have remise released, sold, conveyed and quitclaimed and by these presents do remise release sell convey and quitclaim unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns^{permanently} all the right title, interest, claim and demand which said parties of the first part have in and to the following described lot piece or parcel of land or improvements situated in the City of Tulsa Creek Nation Western District Indian Territory, and known and described as follows to-wit: -

The south seventy-five (75) feet of Lot three (3) in Block one hundred sixty-five (165) in the City of Tulsa Creek Nation, Indian Territory, according to the official government plat thereof being more particularly described, as all of said lot three (3) having a frontage of seventy-five feet on Detroit Avenue, and adjoining south Seventh Street and having a uniform width of seventy-five feet and a depth of One Hundred forty (140) feet to the alley.
