The Muskogee (Creek) Nation
 Indian Territory
 To all to whom these presents shall come
 Greeting:

Whereas a townsite commission, heretofore
 appointed and acting under authority of the
 Act of Congress approved March 1, 1901 (31 Stat.
 861) agreement ratified by the Creek Nation
 May 20 1901 has appraised the lots in the
 town of Tulsa Muskogee (Creek) Nation Indian
 Territory, and whereas, the plat of said
 town was approved by the Secretary of the
 Interior on the 11th day of April 1902 and
 was duly placed on file and

Whereas, said commission has appraised
 all of the town lots included in said
 plat at their true value, excluding improv-
 ments which appraisal has been approved
 by the Secretary of the Interior, and

Whereas the said Commission has awarded
 the real estate described hereunder to George
 R. Brown who has paid, ninety-two & 50/100
 (\$92.50) dollars the full amount of the
 purchase price into the treasury of the
 United States to the credit of the Muskogee
 or Creek nation of Indians with the
 United States Indian Agent at Muskogee
 Indian Territory and is therefore entitled
 to a patent

Now therefore I, the undersigned, the
 Principal Chief of the Muskogee (Creek)
 nation do by virtue of the power and
 authority vested in me by the aforesaid
 Act of the Congress of the United States hereby
 grant George R. Brown his heirs and assigns
 forever all the right title and interest of the
 Muskogee (Creek) Nation aforesaid in and to
 Lot numbered 1-2-3 in Block numbered 54 in
 the town of Tulsa Muskogee (Creek) Nation
 Indian Territory and according to the plat
