

grant of powers to my said attorney is intended to authorize and does authorize my said attorney, if in his judgment such course shall be deemed proper, to advertise the above described lands for sale under the laws, rules and regulations now in force for the sale of lands of allottees of Indian blood, in the Creek nation, or under any laws, rules ^{and} regulations in force hereafter during the continuance of this power of attorney or to apply for the removal of the restrictions upon the lands hereinbefore described under the laws, rules ^{and} regulations now in force regarding the same, or under any laws, rules ^{and} regulations in force hereafter during the continuance of this power of attorney, and upon such sale or removal of the restrictions to do ^{and} perform each and every other power and act hereinbefore provided for, as fully as I myself might do hereby expressly adopting, ratifying, and confirming all that my said attorney shall do in the premises.

And I the said John Tiger (single), for and in consideration of the further sum of One Hundred (\$100) Dollars cash in hand paid me by the said J. W. Ury, have agreed, and covenanted and hereby agree and covenant that the powers herein granted to the said J. W. Ury shall be exclusively exercised by the said J. W. Ury and without any power of revocation by me for and during the full period of five years next ensuing after the date of the execution hereof.
