Adams of Tulsa Indian Territory - District party of the second part for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other good and valuable consideration in hand paid by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has remised, released, sold, conveyed and quit claimed and by these presents does remise release and convey and quit claim unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all the right title interest claim and demand which said party of the first part has in and to the following described lot piece or parcel of land or improvement situated in the Creek Nation Indian Territory - District and known and described as follows to-wit: The west half of the south west quarter of the northwest quarter of the north east quarter and the west half of the east half of the south west quarter of the north west quarter of the north east - of section (18) Township nineteen (19) Range twelve (12) east To Have and to hold the same together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereto belonging or appertaining and all the estate right title interest and claim what ever of the said party of the first part either in law or equity to the only proper use benefit and behoof of said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever.
