 Railroad Company and unto its successors
 and assigns forever for station grounds, for
 mineral facilities and other railroad purposes
 the following described lands situated in
 the Graham District and in the Creek Station
 Indian Reservation Locality: - Commencing on the
 north line of Section fourteen (14) Township
 nineteen (19) north Range twelve (12) east of a
 point 532.6 feet east from the north west
 corner of said Section 14, thence in a southerly
 direction to the said line of the north west
 quarter of said Section 14, at a point 425
 feet east from the south-west corner
 of said Section 14, thence in a southerly direct
 ion to the north line of said Section 14, the
 north west quarter of said Section 14,
 thence east along the south line of the
 north west quarter of said Section 14, a distance
 of 307 feet to a point 125 feet east from the
 south west corner of the north west quarter
 of said Section 14, thence in a northerly direct
 ion to the north line of said Section 14, the
 point 2326 feet east from the north west
 corner of said Section (14), thence east along
