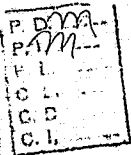

Know all men by these Presents: that we Joe M^cClintock and Maggie M^cClintock his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred (200) Dollars to us in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant bargain sell and forever quit claim unto Mrs Emma J. Owen and unto her heirs and assigns forever and all right title and interest in and to the following lots in the town of Tulsa Western District Indian Territory to wit:

Lot number one and two (1 & 2) in Block one hundred nine (109) as shown by the Government plat of the said Town of Tulsa approved by the Secretary of the Interior To Have and To Hold the same unto the said Emma J. Owen her heirs and assigns forever with all appurtenances thereto belonging.

And I, Maggie M^cClintock wife of the said Joe M^cClintock for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Emma J. Owen all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands aforesaid. Witness our hand and seals on this the 4th day May 1907. Joseph H. M^cClintock

And on the same day also voluntarily appeared before me the said Maggie M^cClintock, wife of the said Joe M^cClintock to me well known and in the absence of her husband declared that she had of her own free will, executed said deed and signed and sealed the relinquishment of dower and homestead in said deed for the consideration and purposes therein contained and set forth without compulsion or undue influence of her said husband.
