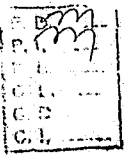

Know all men by these Presents; that we Ed Owen and Ida Owen, his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to us in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant bargain sell and forever quit-claim unto Mrs Emma J. Owen and unto her heirs and assigns forever all our right title and interest in and to the following lots lying in the town of Tulsa Western District Indian Territory to-wit:- Lot number One and Two (1 & 2) in Block One hundred nine (109) as shown by the Government Plat of said Town of Tulsa approved by the Secretary of the Interior To Have and to Hold the same unto the said Emma J. Owen her heirs and assigns forever with all appurtenances thereto belonging, and I, Ida Owen, wife of the said Ed Owen for and in consideration of the said sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Emma J. Owen all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands aforesaid witness our hands and seals on this the 27th day of April 1907.
