Archer for the consideration of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2000) to herin land paid, did execute transfer and deliver a general warranty deed to convey title to the said Frank A. Gillespie covering Lot six (6) in Block eight (8) in the Town of North Tulsa Indian Territory according to the recorded Plat thereof which she had and hereby does for herself her heirs executors administrators warrant the title to said lot to be ^{in every respect} good and sufficient forever and against all claims whatever.
