

This agreement and indenture made and entered into
 this 22nd day of May 1907, by and between Wm. D.
 Dickerson of the Cheyenne Indian Territory party of the
 first part and Big Chief Oil and Gas Company
 of White Indian Territory party of the second
 part WILLMETH:

That the said party of the first part for
 and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and
 the agreements contained here and hereafter
 hereinafter mentioned and provided for, do by these
 presents hereby demise lease and let unto the
 party of the second part for the sole purpose of
 mining and removing oil and gas and under
 the following described tract of land situate
 in the Cheyenne Nation in the Indian Territory
 to-wit:—

That N-4 of the 9. 9-4 of the S E-4 of Section
 32, Township 21 north range 13 east and containing
 ten acres for a period so long as oil and gas
 is found on said land in paying quantities with
 the right to prospect for oil, gas, pipe, stone, refine
 and remove such oil and gas to occupy and use
 so much only of the surface of said land as
 may be reasonably necessary to carry on said
 work, including also the right to obtain from
 wells or other sources on said land by means
 of pipelines or otherwise a sufficient supply
 of water to carry on said operations and
 including still further the right to use such
 oil and gas as fuel or to burn it in machinery
 for the prosecution of said operations. The said
 lessee further covenants and agrees to pay said
 lessor as royalty the sum of twelve and one half
 (12½) per centum of the value on the proceeds
 of all oil and gas actually produced from
 said land, said payments to be made on or before
 the 15th day of the month succeeding its extraction
 or sale. The said lessee further agrees to drill
 three wells on said land beginning on or within one
