Comes now Chauncey A Owens of Tulsa Indian Territory and being first duly sworn upon his oath states:- that he is one and the same person with Chauncey A. Owen who appears variously, as the guardian for Elva Owen, Elva Owens, Addie Owen, Addie Owens, Albert Poage Owen, Albert Poage Owens, Olia Owen, and Olia Owens; that Elva Owen and Elva Owens, appearing in all matters in which he is guardian (are one and the same person as also are Addie Owen and Addie Owens - - - and Albert Poage Owen and Albert Poage Owens and Olia Owen and Olia Owens that he is of record in the Western District of the Indian Territory as guardian for the above minors and for no other persons and that the discrepancy as to names is an error the above minors being on the Indian role of the Creek Tribe of Indian under the name of Owen but being commonly called Owens affiant further states that Martha Owen deceased and Martha Owens deceased are one and the same person and that she was the wife of your affiant and the mother of Elva Owen or Owens, Addie Owen or Owens, Albert Poage Owen or Owens and the grand mother of Olia Owen or Owens.

Affiant further states that he is the Father of Elva Owen or Owens and that she was, prior to the 11th day of May 1906, 18 years of age and that she was prior to May 11th 1907 married to one C. H. Harris and has since that time been known as Elva Harris Further affiant saith not.
