 southwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the southeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$)
 and the west half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the southeast quarter
 ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the south east quarter, all of section twenty-
 nine township, twenty three (23) North range Thirteen
 (13) East, being the allotment of Edward Whitmire
 deceased with all the privileges and appurtenances
 and improvements thereupon situate appertain-
 ing and thereto belonging.
