Owen, aged 60 years, a resident of Tulsa Indian Territory who being first duly sworn according to law before says; that he is the same identical Chancery A. Owen, who served as guardian for Elva Owen, Addie Owen, Albert Foage Owen, and Orla Owen, all minors at the time of his said service; that he, the affiant was the lawful husband of Martha Owen (deceased) that the above named minors Elva Owen, Addie Owen, Albert Foage Owen are the children of the said Martha Owen and himself, and that Orla Owen is the Grandchild of Martha Owen; being the daughter of Dora Pendleton who was a daughter of Martha Owen; that his said wife Martha Owen was entitled to an allotment as a Creek citizen and chose as a portion of her allotment the S.E. Quarter 44s of the N.W. Quarter (44) and the east half (1/2) of the N.W. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of the 44s and 45s, all in Section two (2) Township nineteen (19), north Range twelve (12), east as is evidenced by deed No. 28256 in the Creek Nation Indian Territory; that his wife Martha Owen, died before receiving her allotment deed leaving as her sole and only heirs Daisy Martha Charles, Fieley, Elva Owen, Addie Owen, Albert Foage Owen and Orla Owen; that his said wife was first married to Crook Pendleton; that Dora Pendleton and Daisy Pendleton are the children of his said wife Martha and the said Crook Pendleton; that Dora Pendleton is now deceased leaving her interest in the said estate to her child Orla; now known as Orla, an illegitimate child as her only issue; the said Dora Pendleton never having been married and leaving no other children; that Orla Pendleton
