Deed of Release

Know all men by these Presents: that the Union Trust Company (an Indian Territory Corporation) of Tulsa Ind Ter., for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand and Sixty five ~~no~~ Dollars to it paid by W. J. Randolph does hereby grant sell quit claim and release unto the said ^{H.W. Randolph, Trustee, his heirs and assigns} described real estate lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory to wit:-

all of Lot seven (7) in Block Three (3) and all of Lot seven (7) in Block Five (5) Bellview Addition to the City of Tulsa Indian Territory

This deed is made to release the lien of a certain mortgage dated March 10th, 1906 and recorded March 12th, 1906 at 207 - in Book - - at Page of the records of mortgages at Sapulpa Ind Ter. This deed of release is made by the un-designated officer of the Union Trust Company in pursuance of the authority conferred upon him in Article VI of the by-laws of said Company as follows:

The secretary shall have equal power with the President to satisfy and release mortgages, judgments or certificates of trust; to execute contracts, releases or other instruments in the transaction of the company's business.
