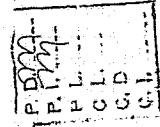

Release of Mortgage
 Know all men by these Presents: That L. J. Martin of Tulsa Indian Territory for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$100) Dollar in hand paid by Henry W. Perryman and Gertrude Perryman his wife the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and confessed do hereby, grant, sell, quit claim and release unto the said Henry W. Perryman and Gertrude Perryman his wife and unto their heirs and assigns forever the following described property to wit: - The north half of the south-west quarter and the south-west quarter of the south-west quarter of section eight, township eighteen north range thirteen east. This instrument being made to release the lien of a certain mortgage, dated the 26th day of July 1906 recorded on the 28th day of July 1906 in Book 3, Page 22, at the office of the U. S. Deputy Clerk and Ex-officio Recorder at Tulsa Indian Territory, given by Henry W. Perryman and Gertrude Perryman his wife conveying the property herein described to L. J. Martin to secure the payment of Two Hundred \$200.00 dollars, said mortgage having been fully paid and satisfied.
