assigns forever the following described real-
estate lying in the Eighth recording district
of the Indian Territory to wit:- The southerly
fifty (50) feet of Lots Four (4) and five (5) in Block
One hundred ninety three 193, according to the
original plat of the Town of Tulsa Creek Nation
Indian Territory as approved by the Sec-
retary of Interior April 11 1902.

This deed being to release the
lien of a certain mortgage dated May 10th
1907 in Book - at Page - of the records of the eighth
recording district of the Indian Territory by W.E.
Strickland & wife M.C. Strickland conveying
said real estate to C.D. Coggeshall to secure payment
of their certain note therein named, the same having
been fully paid.
