being situate in the - Creek Nation
Western District of the Indian Territory:

The south west quarter of the south east quarter
and the south east quarter of the south east quarter
of section eight (8) and the the north east quarter of
the north east quarter and the south west quarter
of the north east quarter section nine (9) all
in township seventeen (17) north Range four-
teen (14) east of the Indian Base and Meridian of
the Indian Territory and according to the Govern-
ment Survey therefor; same being the allotment of
James Wallace deceased. To Have and To hold the
same unto the International Land Company its
successors heirs and assigns forever which all
appurtenances thereto belonging. And I, Ben White
hereby covenants with the said International Land
Company that said lands, are free from all em-
brances, that I will forever warrant and defend
the title to said lands against all ^{world} claimants.
