

Warranty Deed
of 24 883-Deed

John C. Smock, ^{by power} ^{his wife} To B. H. Mills
(Creek) Nation Indian Territory for and in consideration of the sum of Seventy-five ^{and 1/2} dollars to us paid by B. H. Mills receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant bargain sell and convey unto the said B. H. Mills his and assigns forever, the following described lot or parcel of ground lying and being situate in the Western District of the Creek Nation of the Indian Territory to-wit: -

The east half of the west half of the south-east quarter of the south east quarter of the north east quarter of section thirty-five (35) Township sixteen (16) north range three (2) east of the Indian Base and meridian in Indian Territory, containing two and one half (2 1/2) acres more or less.

To Have and To Hold the same unto the said B. H. Mills his and assigns forever with all appurtenances thereto belonging.

And John C. Smock and Elvise G. Smock hereby covenants with the said B. H. Mills that said lands are free from all incumbrances, that they will ^{power} warrant and defend the title to said lands against all lawful claims whatever.

And Elvise G. Smock wife of the said John C. Smock for and in consideration of said sum of money do hereby release unto the said B. H. Mills all my right of dower and heretofore and to said lands.
