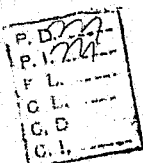


Warranty Deed.

Know, all men by men by these Presents

that we Lewis W. Sango and Polly Sango his wife, father

and mother and only heirs-at-law of Harry Sango deceased of City of Muskogee, Muskogee Creek Nation Indian Territory for and in consideration of the sum of Eighty-five (\$85.00) dollars to them paid by W. E. Rowsey, Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant bargain sell and convey unto the said W. E. Rowsey his heirs and assigns forever the following described lot or parcel of ground lying and being situate in the Creek Nation, Western District of the Indian Territory to wit:

The south-west ten acres of Lot 2 Section 5, township 15, north range 13, east of the Indian Base and meridian, according to the Government survey thereof.

To Have and to Hold the same unto the said W. E. Rowsey his heirs and assigns forever with all appurtenances thereto belonging

And the said Lewis W. Sango and Polly Sango hereby covenants with the said W. E. Rowsey that said lands are free from all incumbrances that we will forever warrant and defend the title to said lands against all lawful claims whomever

And Polly Sango, wife of the said Lewis W. Sango for and in consideration of said sum of money, do hereby release unto the said W. E. Rowsey, all my right of dower and homestead in and to said lands.
