Woods and Augusta Woods his wife and unto their heirs and assigns forever the following real-estate lying in the twenty eighth recording District of the Indian of the Indian Territory to-wit: South half of Lots eleven (11) twelve (12) thirteen (13) fourteen (14) and fifteen (15) in Block twelve (12) Burnett Addition to Tulsa Indian Territory containing in all 70 feet frontage on Lansing Street or are with all improvements thereon. This deed being to release the lien of a certain deed of mortgage dated March 1, 1907 and recorded March 2 1907 in Book - at Page - being file No 3000 of the records of the twenty eighth recording, district of the Indian territory by N.C. Woods and Augusta Woods his wife conveying said real estate to Farmers National Bank to secure payment of One certain note of \$289.00 therein named the same having been fully paid.
