 trust for them and to pay them the amount
 due them at the time they reach full age.

Item 5 I give, bequeath and devise to my
 sister Done L. Stiggleman as trustee the
 sum of Twenty-eight hundred Dollars $\$2800^{\circ}$
 which sum I desire her to invest, as she sees
 fit and during the life time of my brother
 Frederick W Lyman to pay him semi annually
 the net proceeds of such investment after paying
 taxes and other expenses. It is my desire that
 no part of said income should go to pay any
 of the debts of my said brother Frederick W.
 Lyman and if his interest in the same should be
 levied upon or attached then I desire the said
 trustee to use the same for the benefit of himself
 and family, and at the death of the said Frederick
 W. Lyman I desire that said trust shall terminate
 and that out of the principal sum of $\$2800^{\circ}$ the
 said trustee shall first pay to each of the children
 of the said Frederick W. Lyman the sum of Four
 Hundred and Fifty Dollars $\$450^{\circ}$ a piece, and that
 the balance of the said sum of $\$2800^{\circ}$ shall be
 divided between the living children of my said
 sister Anna M. Coggeshall and my said brother
 Frederick W. Lyman share and share alike.
