This agreement made and entered into this 27th

 itory of Indian of the second part Witnesseth
 that the said party of the first part hereby sells
 to the said party of the second part the following
 described real estate to wit: That part of Lot 5 of
 Block 47 in Tulsa Indian Territory described as
 follows: beginning at a point 110 ft east of the south
 west corner of said lot 5 in Block 47 running thence
 100 feet north on a parallel line with Greenwood
 Street thence 25 feet east on a parallel line
 with north first street thence 100 feet south to
