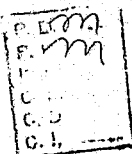

Lot five (5) of P. H. Rea's subdivision of the north-east quarter (1/4) of Block One Hundred and five (105) in the City of Tulsa Indian Territory in accordance with the description of said subdivision and plat thereon shown in the deed of dedication of any alley in said subdivision of the said northeast quarter (1/4) of said Block one hundred and five (105) made by P. Rea and wife Frances Rea on the 16th day of January 1903 to the incorporated City of Tulsa Indian Territory and filed for record January 29th 1903 in the office of the U.S. District Court for the District of Oklahoma and recorded in Book 2 Page 141 of the records of said office in said City of Sapulpa Indian Territory. To Have and to hold the same unto the said Elva C. Barrows and unto his heirs and assigns forever with all appurtenances thereunto belonging

And hereby covenants with the said Elva C. Barrows that we will forever warrant and defend the title to said lands against all claims whatever except the taxes for the year 1907 and the street paving taxes now levied or to be hereafter levied
