



5581 Rental Contract

This Indenture of Lease made and entered into this 30th day of July 1907 by and between Hester Bruner, party of the first part and R. M. Rowe party of the second part Witnesseth:-

That the party of the first part hereby demises unto the party of the second part for a period of five (5) years from and after the date the following described premises to wit: South east quarter of Section twelve (12) township nineteen (19) north Range fourteen (14) east Creek Nation Indian Territory; said land is leased and is to be used for agricultural purposes for which the party of the second part agrees to pay to the party of the first part the sum of Fifty Dollars each in land the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged for the full term covered by this contract. It is further agreed that the party of the second part will at the expiration of the time covered by this contract surrender possession of the above described premises to the party of the first part in as good condition as when received ordinary wear and tear excepted.
