Know all men by these Presents: That the Union Trust Company an Indian Territory Corporation of Tulsa Ind Ter; for and in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars to it paid by Adesta F. Berry does hereby grant, sell, quit claim and release unto the said Adesta F. Berry Josephine Berry & Louise B. Berry, and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory to wit: Lots nos seven (7), eight (8), nine (9), ten (10), eleven (11), twelve (12), thirteen (13), fourteen (14), fifteen (15), sixteen (16), seventeen (17), eighteen (18), nineteen (19), twenty (20), twenty one (21), twenty-two (22), twenty-three (23) twenty-four (24) in Block ten (10) in Berry's addition to Tulsa Indian Territory; This deed being made to release (only so far as it affects the above described property) the lien of a certain mortgage date December 31, 1906 and recorded January 2nd 1907 at 11 A.M. in Book 11 at Page 4 of the records of mortgages at Tulsa Ind Ter. This deed of release is made by the undersigned officer of the Union Trust Company in pursuance of the authority conferred upon him in Article VII of the by-laws of said Company as follows. The Secretary shall have equal power with the President to satisfy and release mortgages, judgments or certificates of trust; to execute contracts releases or other instruments in the transaction of the Company's business.
