Know all men by these Presents: that whereas, on the 1st day of October A.D. 1906 a mortgage was executed by Edward Crowell to Coweta State Bank, a corporation organized under the laws of Indiana for the consideration therein expressed upon the following property to-wit: Western District Creek nation Ind Ter., the west one half $\frac{1}{2}$ of the south east one quarter $\frac{1}{4}$ of the south west quarter $\frac{1}{4}$ and the south west quarter $\frac{1}{4}$ of the south west quarter $\frac{1}{4}$ and the south west quarter $\frac{1}{4}$ of the south east quarter $\frac{1}{4}$ all in section sixteen (6) Township twenty (20) north range fourteen (14) east containing twenty acres more or less, said mortgage having been filed for record on the 1 day of September A.D. 1907 and recorded in Book 1 at Page 392 in the office of the Deputy Clerk of the United States Court and ex officio Recorder at Tulsa Indian Territory, and which was given to secure the payment of a note for \$256.⁰⁰.

And whereas; said indebtedness has been paid and satisfied in full:

Now in consideration of the payment of said indebtedness in full and other considerations to said Coweta State Bank in hand paid by said Edward Crowell the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Coweta State Bank has granted, released - quit-claimed and set over and by these presents does hereby grant release quit-claim and set over unto the said Edward Crowell her heirs and assigns all its right, title and interest, in and to said mortgaged property, together with all the accretions and appurtenances thereunto belonging to the intent that the property hereby conveyed may be discharged from said mortgage.

To Have and to Hold the lands and premises hereby released and conveyed unto the said Edward Crowell his heirs and assigns
