5-387 Rental Contract

For Agricultural Purposes

Made and executed this 4th day of October 1904 by and between Siney Vann of Stillwell I.T., for and on behalf of himself party of the first part hereinafter called the lessor and W. A. Cook of Tulsa I.T. party of the second part hereafter called the lessee. Now Therefore in consideration of \$3000⁰⁰ being the purchase price for the improvements now on the land below described the lessor rents to the lessee his successors or assigns the following described tracts of lands situated in the Cherokee Nation Indian Territory to-wit:-

North $\frac{1}{2}$ of the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section (29) Township (21) north range 14 east containing eighty acres

To Have and To Hold said premises for agricultural purposes for a term of five years from the date hereof for the consideration herein before stated the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged.

The lessor agrees that possession to the above lands shall be given to the lessee from and after this date.
