

now Therefore I the undersigned, The Principal Chief of the Muskogee Creek Nation do by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the aforesaid Act of the Congress of the United States hereby grant sell and convey unto the said Henry R. Cline Louis M. Poe Francis M. Kelley Washington M. Wilson and Wyatt T Brady Trustees First Methodist Episcopal Church South of Tulsa O. T., successors and assigns forever all the right title and interest of the Muskogee (Creek) nation aforesaid in, and to Lot numbered 6 in Block numbered 107 in the town of Tulsa Muskogee (Creek) Nation Indian Territory and according to the plat thereof on file as aforesaid.

In Witness Whereof, The Principal Chief of the Muskogee Creek Nation have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of said Nation to be affixed at the date hereinafter shown.
