

as follows: ten dollars on this day and date the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and Fifteen Dollars on the first day of January 1908 and twenty five dollars on the first day of July 1908 ^{the last payment} it being always understood and agreed that ^{of the} said rent shall not be due and payable until the said E. E. Lewis shall have been placed by Casser Simon in the quiet and actual possession of said land.

It is distinctly agreed — that this lease is for farming purposes. It is further agreed that the following improvements shall be placed upon the said land during the term of this lease to keep the improvements now on said land in good repair the usual wear and tare accepted.
