Know all men by these Presents: that I, Albert Truitt on this 24th day of August 1907 for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred eighty and ^{no}100 Dollars have bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents delivered to Henry Schafer the following described property the title to which I guarantee to wit:-

Two black horse mules about 15 1/2 hands high each weigh about 1050[#] each mealy noded, age 5- & 6 years named Mark and Mike.

I also guarantee that said mules are well broken and good pullers.

Unto the said Henry Schafer his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever.

I guarantee that I am the owner and entitled to sell and dispose of the said property and further guarantee that there are no liens, mortgages or other encumbrances on the said property.
