Know all men by these Presents that I, Samuel Johnson, a citizen of the Creek Nation having selected for myself the following described tracts of land lying and being in the Creek Nation; the ^{north} east ^{part} of the north-east quarter of the section 2 township 17 north range 13 east, all of the said tracts of land having been set aside and allotted to Samuel Johnson by the Commission to the Five Civilized Tribes.

I, the said Samuel Johnson for myself and for the consideration hereinafter expressed have let, leased and demised and do by these presents let lease and demise unto the Southern Oil & Land Co., a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the United States and having its principal place of business at Muskogee Indian Territory its successors and assigns all of the above described property for a term of five years from and after the 6th day of September 1907 and I covenant with the said Southern Oil & Land Co., that I am the legal owner of the above described land and that I, and my heirs and assigns will protect the said The Southern Oil & Land Co., its successors and assigns in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said above described land for the full term of this Lease.

And I, Samuel Johnson, do further covenant with the said — that I have made no lease upon the said land for the period of time covered by this lease and that I will place the said The Southern Oil & Land Co., in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said land prior before the beginning of the term of this Lease.

For the above consideration the said The Southern Oil & Land Co., hereby agrees and promises to pay unto the said Samuel Johnson the sum of One Dollar and other
