Know all men by these  
Presents: That I, George  
W. Adams, being the  
owner of the west half  
of the south-west quarter

of the north-west quarter of Section 36, Town-  
ship 20, North Range 12, East, have caused  
the same to be surveyed and staked and  
platted into town lots, blocks, streets and
