does hereby Grant, Bargain, Sell and convey unto

District, Indian Territory, to-wit:

1/2 Lot No. twelve (12) Block No. fifteen (15)

1/2 Lot No. twenty two (22) in Block No. twenty four (24)

according to the survey and plat filed thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said grantee and unto her heirs and assigns forever, with all  
appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenants with said grantee that it will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against  
all claims whatever.
