

This Agreement, Made and entered into this the 10th day of February 1908 by and between
Joe H. Piger, a Citizen of the Creek Nation, Indian Territory and
enrolled on the C&K Tribal Roll as a Creek noting for original allottee.
Frederick, single and un years old, married of Tulsa County years old,

citizens of the Creek Nation, party of the first part and the D. H. Oglesby (Party of the second part).

WITNESSETH, That for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter made by the party of the second part, the party of the first part has this day and by these presents rented unto the party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns for agricultural purposes, for the term of five years from the 10th day of February 1908, the following described parcels of land:

The North East Quarter of the North East Quarter of
 Section 24, Township 19 North, Range Twelve (12), East
 in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma.

It is understood and agreed that the party of the second part will pay said party of the first part a cash rental of \$ 100.00
 per annum during the term of this contract, payable as follows:
 Cash paid this day 10.00 and \$ 50.00 directly on Saturday night each week until \$ 40.00 is paid
 payable January 1, 1909, \$ 50.00 payable January 1, 1910, \$ 100.00 payable January 1, 1910, \$ 100.00 payable January 1, 1911, \$ 100.00 payable January 1, 1912, \$ 100.00 payable January 1, 1913.

Party of second part is to have the possession and occupancy of said premises on Jan. 1st 1909 and rent is to begin from said date and forth party obligated himself to give possession on said date and \$ 10.00 cash now paid in hand, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the party of the first part.

All payments are due and payable at the Residence of party of the second part on demand in person. The party of the first part represents that he has full authority to make such lease. That above described land is not leased to anyone else whatever, and that the stipulations of this lease shall be faithfully carried out by the party of the first part.

It is further agreed that the party of the second part has the exclusive privilege of cultivating said land and enclosing the same with a fence sufficient to turn hogs, cattle, horses or other stock, and by erecting improvements as may be found expedient, and shall have the right to clear away and dispose of the timber thereon, and that this lease is for agricultural purposes.

All buildings, ~~houses~~ and improvements erected upon said land shall remain the property of said party of the second part upon the expiration of this contract and he shall have the right to remove same from said premises, in case party of first part is empowered to sell said land and he shall make a sale of same during the term of this lease and party agrees to surrender the possession thereof at the end of the succeeding current year after all his crops and improvements are removed upon the payment to him by said party of the sum of Two hundred dollars.

The several representations in this contract are made by the party of the first part for the purpose of obtaining the money agreed on.
