WITNESSETH, That whereas the said part y of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred
and fifty (350⁰⁰) DOLLARS,
 to Kathleen P. Black nee Butler
 in hand paid by said alex S Lewis

the receipt whereof is hereby duly acknowledged, he S sold, and by these presents do S hereby Give, Grant, Bargain, Sell, Convey and
 Confirm unto the said part y of the second part, h heirs and assigns, in fee simple, forever, all that tract or parcel of land, situated
 in the Town of Cherokee Nation, District of the
 Indian Territory, according to the United States Survey and official plat thereof, as made by the
 Townsite Commission and approved by the Secretary of the Interior of the United States, bound and described as follows, to-wit:

quarter; the south east quarter of the north west
quarter of the north west quarter, the north half
of the north west quarter of the north west
quarter of section twenty six (26) the north half of
the north east quarter of the north east quarter of
section twenty seven (27) and the south east
quarter of the south west quarter of the south east
quarter of section twenty two (22) all of township
twenty (20) north Range thirteen (13) east

Together with all and singular the privileges, improvements, tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
 anywise appertaining, with all the estate, title and interest of said part y of the first part therein.

The said part y grantor hereby covenants with the said part y grantee that she is the lawful owner of the said parcel
 or tract of land; that the title thereof is in her; that she is seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance
 therein, and has a lawful right to sell and convey the same; that there are no liens or mortgages on said property of any kind or
 nature whatsoever.

And the said part y of the first part hereby covenants and agrees with the said part y of the second part that he will, and
heirs, executors and administrators shall, forever warrant and defend the title to the said lands against all lawful and
equitable claims and demands whatsoever.

 and quit-claim unto the said heirs and assigns, all my rights, claim
 or dower, and my homestead or possibility of dower or homestead, in and to the aforesaid premises.
