

This Indenture, Made this 16th day of September A. D. 1907, between
Kittie E Butler and her wife,
 of the City of
Mustage in the Western District of the Indian Territory, part Y of the first part, and
Alex Lewis
 of Lawson Indian Territory part Y of the second part,

WITNESSETH, That whereas the said part Y of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred and Fifty (300) DOLLARS,
 to Kittie E Butler in hand paid by said Alex Lewis
 the receipt whereof is hereby duly acknowledged, has sold, and by these presents does hereby Give, Grant, Bargain, Sell, Convey and
 Confirm unto the said part Y of the second part, his heirs and assigns, in fee simple, forever, all that tract or parcels of land, situated
 in the Town of Cherokee Nation, District of the
 Indian Territory, according to the United States Survey and official plat thereof, as made by the
 Townsite Commission and approved by the Secretary of the Interior of the United States, located and described as follows to-wit:

The east half of south west quarter of north west
quarter south east quarter of north west quarter of
section twenty six (26) north half of north
east quarter of northeast quarter of section twenty seven
and south east quarter of south west quarter
of section twenty-two (22) all of township twenty two
north Range thirteen East.

Together with all and singular the privileges, improvements, tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
 anywise appertaining, with all the estate, title and interest of said part Y of the first part therein.

The said part Y grantor hereby covenants with the said part Y grantee that he is the lawful owner of the said parcel
 or tract of land; that the title thereof is in her; that she is seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance
 therein, and has a lawful right to sell and convey the same; that there are no liens or mortgages on said property of any kind or
 nature whatsoever.

And the said part Y of the first part hereby covenants and agrees with the said part Y of the second part, that she will, and
her heirs, executors and administrators shall, forever warrant and defend the title to the said lands against all lawful and
 equitable claims and demands whatsoever.

And I, Kittie E Butler wife of the said
 for and in consideration of the said sum of money, and for divers and other good and valuable considerations, do hereby release, relinquish
 and quit-claim unto the said Alex Lewis his heirs and assigns, all my rights, claim
 or dower, and my homestead or possibility of dower or homestead, in and to the aforescribed premises.
