

This Instrument, Made, executed and delivered this 30th day of May 1905, by and between Huletta T. Aky (single man) of Owasa Indian Territory, party of the first part, and W. H. Wood party of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars, the receipt

whereof is hereby acknowledged, the first party has Granted, Bargained, Sold and Conveyed, and by these presents does hereby Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the second party, his heirs and assigns, the following described real property, lying and situate in the Town of Skitchok Cherokee Nation, Northern District, Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot Twenty-two (22) Block Eleven (11), as is shown by the recorded plat thereof.

Together with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said second party, his heirs and assigns, forever.

And the said first party hereby covenants and agrees with the said second party that at the execution and delivery hereof, the first party is the owner of the above described premises, free and clear of any incumbrances whatever, and will forever warrant and defend the title to the said real property in and to the second party, his heirs and assigns, against all claims or acts of the first party and those of all persons claiming by, through or under him.
