

This Indenture, Made this 22 day of August A. D. 1903, between
Frank W. Gale and his wife,
Mabel Gale of the City of
Chicago in the State of Illinois District of the Indian Territory, part 1st of the first part, and
William H. Henderson
 of Tulsa part 2d of the second part,

WITNESSETH, That whereas the said part 1st of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred
 (600⁰⁰) DOLLARS,

to — in hand paid by said William H. Henderson
 the receipt whereof is hereby duly acknowledged, has — sold, and by these presents do — hereby Give, Grant, Bargain, Sell, Convey and
 Confirm unto the said part 2d of the second part, — heirs and assigns, in fee simple, forever, all that tract or parcel of land, situated
 in the Town of Tulsa Creek Nation, Western District of the
 Indian Territory, according to the United States Survey and official plat thereof, as made by the Creek
 Townsite Commission, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior of the United States, bound and described as follows, to-wit:

The south 1/2 of lot numbered two (2) and
 the north 25 feet of lot numbered three (3) in
 block number one hundred and fifty, 150 as shown
 by the Government plat of said town approved
 by the Secretary of the Interior

Together with all and singular the privileges, improvements, tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in
 anywise appertaining, with all the estate, title and interest of said part 1st of the first part therein.

The said part 1st grantor hereby covenant with the said part 2d grantee that the — the lawful owner — of the said parcel
 or tract of land; that the title thereof is in them; that the — seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance
 therein, and has — a lawful right to sell and convey the same; that there are no liens or mortgages on said property of any kind or
 nature whatsoever.

And the said part 1st of the first part hereby covenant and agree with the said part 2d of the second part, that the — will, and
their heirs, executors and administrators shall, forever warrant and defend the title to the said lands against all lawful and
 equitable claims and demands whatsoever.

And I, Mabel Gale wife of the said Frank W. Gale
 for and in consideration of the said sum of money, and for divers and other good and valuable considerations, do hereby release, relinquish
 and quit-claim unto the said William H. Henderson heirs and assigns, all my rights, claim
 or dower, and my homestead or possibility of dower or homestead, in and to the aforescribed premises.
