RENTAL CONTRACT.

This Agreement, Made and entered into this the 27th day of February 1907 by and between

 party of the first part, and

Witnesseth. That for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter made by the party of the first part, the party of the second part, this day, and by these presents, do demise and let to the party of the second part, its executors, administrators, heirs and assigns, for agricultural purposes, for the term of years from the 27th day of February 1907, the following described parcels of land situated in Section Township N., Range E. NW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Section Twenty (20) Township Twenty (20) North Range Fourteen (14) East containing Seventy acres more or less, Township N., Range E. Section Township N., Range E. It is understood and agreed that the party of the second part will pay said party of the first part a rental of \$ per annum during the term of this contract, payable as follows:

For twenty-five no less than annum as follows:

To begin on August 1st of each year, and after possession is given to the party of the second part, the said party of the second part agrees to build a good two room house, and lay a well on said place and to enclose all of said land under a three wire fence, and to place said improvements on said land before the expiration of this contract.
