Witnesseth, That for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter made by the part 4 of the second part, the part 4 of the first part this day and by these presents do demise and let to the part 4 of the second part its successors heirs and assigns, for agricultural purposes, for the term of Five years from the 19<sup>th</sup> day of July 1907 the following described parcels of land: north half of the north west quarter of Section 32 Township 24 N., Range 13 E of Section Township N., Range E of Section Township N., Range E of Section Township N., Range E

It is understood and agreed that the part 4 of the second part will pay said part 4 of the first part a rental of \$5.00 as follows to wit: the sum of Five hundred (\$500.00) for the full term of five years which amount is hereby paid in advance the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the party of the first part.
