

# Release of Mortgage.

(CORPORATION.)

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PREMISES, That, Whereas, on the 14th day of March A. D. 1906

a mortgage was executed by G. L. Holt, and Lallie B. Holt

to First State Bank of Broken Arrow, I.T. a corporation organized under the laws of Indian Territory for the consideration therein expressed, upon the following property, to-wit: Lots 13, 14, 15 and 16 in Block 75 in the Town of Broken Arrow, I.T.

To have and to hold the lands and premises hereby released and conveyed unto the said G. L. Holt

his heirs and assigns, and to their proper use, benefit and behoof, forever, free, clear and discharged of and from all lien and claim under and by virtue of the mortgage aforesaid.
