RENTAL CONTRACT.

This Agreement, Made and entered into this 28th day of Aug. 1907 by and between

 unable to work, that his son, L. O. Faast, has paid
 the sum of \$25.00 for medical attention furnished said lessor,
 Brusner, and agrees to pay the sum of one dollar per day until
 he is able to work, that for said sum of money, Brusner,
 agrees to lease unto this contract, namely, that he will make
 a warranty deed to L. O. Faast to the North half of N. W. quarter
 of the S. E. 27 Township 18 N., Range 13 E., and the N. E. quarter of the
 S. E. quarter of sec. 27 Township 18 N., Range 13 E., as soon as he can
 make good title to same, subject to the appraised value of said land
 as placed thereon by the above named attorney, and
 witnesseth, That for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter made by the part

part of the first part this day and by these presents
 do demise and let to the part of the second part his heirs and assigns, for purposes, for the term of
 five years from the 28 day of Aug. 1907 the following

described parcels of land:

 The N. E. quarter of the S. E. quarter

It is understood and agreed that the part of the second part will pay said part of the first part a rental of \$ Twenty per annum during the term of this
