This Agreement, Made and entered into this 11th day of August 1906 by and between
Nancy Tecumseh
of Muskogean Indian Territory, for and on behalf of Road Den
her son citizens of the Creek nation parties of the first part and
E Reynolds
party of the second part

Witnesseth, That for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter made by the part of the second part, the
part of the first part
do demise and let to the part of the second part his heirs and assigns, for agricultural
purposes, for the term of
5 years from the 1st day of January 1907 the following
described parcels of land:

1/2 of the SE 1/4 of Section 22 Township 17 N., Range 14 E.
1/2 of the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 22 Township 17 N., Range 14 E.
NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 23 Township 17 N., Range 14 E.
NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 28 Township 17 N., Range 14 E.

It is understood and agreed that the part of the second part will pay said parties of the first part a rental of \$ 50⁰⁰
(fifty dollars) per annum during the term of this
contract, payable as follows:

Ten dollars (\$10.00) cash to me in hand paid
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and
50⁰⁰ on this first day of January of each year
after January 1907 during the term of this lease
and the peaceful possession of the land herein
mentioned unto the party of the second part
