

RENTAL CONTRACT.

This Agreement, Made and entered into this 1st day of June 1907 by and between
Polly Step
 of Essexville, Arkansas part 4 of the first part, and
Wesley E. Fowler of Owasso, Indian Territory
 party of the second part.

Witnesseth, That for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter made by the part 4 of the second part, the
 part 4 of the first part this day and by these presents
 do demise and let to the part 4 of the second part his heirs and assigns, for grazing purposes, for the term of
Five years from the 1st day of June 1907 the following
 described parcels of land:

East one half of the north east quarter of Section 23 Township 21 N., Range 13 E
 of Section Township N., Range E
 of Section Township N., Range E
 of Section Township N., Range E

It is understood and agreed that the part 4 of the second part will pay said part 4 of the first part a rental of \$10.00 Ten
and no more Dollars per annum during the term of this
 contract, payable as follows:

Ten dollars payable on the signing of this contract and ten
dollars on the first day of June 1908. Ten dollars on the
1st day of June 1909. Ten dollars on the 1st day of June
1910 and ten dollars on the 1st day of June 1911

In addition to the payment of cash rental as above
stipulated the party of the second part agrees to place around
the tract of land above described good old posts sixteen feet
apart and to place thereon three strings of galvanized wire. The
same to be done within one year after the signing of this
contract and the failure of the party of the second part to
comply with his part of the contract shall render the same null and
void.
